The University of Pittsburgh Library System (ULS) is pleased to provide notecards featuring reproductions from John James Audubon's double elephant folio edition of the *Birds of America*. The notecards represent a set of some of our favorite birds. Each set consists of twelve 5" x 7" blank notecards with matching white envelopes. Each set will have one of each of the following birds:

Wild Turkey (1), Carolina Parrot (26), Painted Finch (53), Passenger Pigeon (62), Pileated Woodpecker (111), Eastern Bluebird (113), Snowy Owl (121), Ruffed Grouse (41), Roseate Spoonbill (321), Blue Crane or Heron (307), Mallard Duck (221), Scarlet Ibis (397)
